



GENDER STUDIES CERTIFICATE

The interdisciplinary focus module "Gender Studies" is coordinated at the Philosophy Faculty of Leibniz University. This module enables students to further their interest and expand their knowledge in the field of Gender and Queer Studies. After completing the necessary requirement of completing four classes with a Studienleistung, the student receives a certificate. Classes will be held in English and German.

The classes visited in the course of this module should cover at least one of the following four topics:

- Analysis of historical and contemporary structures and representations of gender and sexuality
- Contemporary contextualizing of theories of Gender and/ or Queer Studies
- Introduction of feminist theory /men's studies
- Introduction in Queer Studies / Diversity Studies
- Critical Whiteness-Studies

Prerequisites for completing the Studienschwerpunkt and acquiring a certificate:

Students attend four courses of their choice in one of the cooperating departments.

It is obligatory to earn a Studienleistung in the course of the class. Students who write a Bachelor or Master thesis about a gender related topic are exempt from one Studienleistung.

We advise you to limit the course of the Studienschwerpunkt to 4 semesters.

The certificate is obtained by attending four events. Extra registration is not required. The final certification takes place via the signature of the contact person.
